"Preparing for a Ministry Position," by Ron Bontrager

1. The Cover Letter: The goal of this letter is to convince the readers that they should read your resume. It should be one page in length and void of abbreviations.

Include the following:

- a. The position you are seeking
- b. How you heard about the job. If you previously spoke with someone, mention this first (e.g., "I enjoyed speaking with John Smith recently, who informed me that the Main Street congregation is looking for a preacher.")
- c. What you are currently doing
- d. Family information
- e. Your qualifications for the position
- f. 1-2 highlights of your current work and/or education
- g. Reference to the enclosed resume
- h. In the last paragraph, include when you will be available for an interview
- **2.** The Resume: The goal of your resume is to produce a 1-2 page document that will result in an invitation for an interview.

Include the following:

- a. Personal information: name, address (include e-mail), phone number, date of birth, date of baptism, wife's name, anniversary, children's names and ages
- b. Objective statement (optional)
- c. Recent employment history, beginning with the most recent, or ministry experience (if you have never had a "preaching job")
- d. Education, beginning with the most recent, to high school
- e. Names, addresses and phone numbers, and positions (that show a relationship to you) of those who can give a word of recommendation (3-4 people who can speak accurately and commendably regarding your education, employment, and ministry experience and potential)
- f. Additional information
 - 1) A recent family photo
 - 2) A tape of a recent sermon (a video recording is often preferred)
 - 3) Write in outline form, not manuscript
 - 4) Use special resume paper
 - 5) Do not include any of the following: personal hobbies and interests, salary requests, reasons for leaving previous employments
 - 6) Save additional information for the interview

General principles: be brief, accurate, relevant, well-organized, and attractive; use correct spelling, punctuation, and grammar.
